4-H Enrollments

- An approved active enrollment in 4-H is required to participate in practices, meetings, contest, and events.
- ALL 4-H members showing animals must be an approved 4-H member no later than NOVEMBER 1st

School Excuses

- Eligibility will be checked with schools for any youth competing in events that require 4-H membership.
 - This includes all events regardless of the level the event takes place and regardless of what day it falls on.
- Events that do not require 4-H membership will not be eligible for a 4-H school excuse.

Fees & Invoices

- There is a 3.5% charge for all Debit/Credit card payments.
- Contest fees and registration payments are nonrefundable.
- If you commit to participate in a contest/event, you are responsible for the fees.
- Contest fees and registrations must be paid for BEFORE the event.



*Heifers that are already validated, and have not changed breed/ownership, do not need to be revalidated with a tag.

*There will still be two validation seasons for heifers (June and October)

HORSE VALIDATION

March 1st to April 15th

\$10.00 per horse

The \$10.00 cost is only guaranteed if the animal validation is approved by the county office by the April 15th deadline and the payment is processed.

April 16th to May 1st


\$20.00 per horse

The \$20.00 cost is only guaranteed if the animal validation is approved by the county office by the May 1st deadline and the payment is processed.

Validation and payment is required of ALL horses regardless if they were entered this year or last!

All horses will be validated through your family profile on 4H Online

PAYMENTS - Only credit card payments are allowed for animal validation from families.


